

# In School Program Guide

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We are happy to announce that Cold Creek continues to offer in school programming for the 2023 season! With a mix of recreation and educational programs, there is something for everyone at the comfort of your own school!



#### **Ultimate Survival**

1/2 day program or 1/4 day program Grade Appropriate: 3-12

This physically active program focuses on connections within the food chain of a given ecosystem. Participants will learn the importance of balance in the food chain and how the relationship between predator and prey is crucial to sustaining a healthy ecosystem, while trying to keep themselves alive in a fun filled interactive game.

#### Orienteering

1/2 day program or 1/4 day program Grade Appropriate: 4-12

Participants get to learn the basics of orienteering and explore the outdoors as they navigate through an interactive orienteering course. With a compass in hand, students will set out on a challenge course that will test and improve their navigational skills. This program includes an in depth explanation of how to read and use a compass as well as skill testing activities.

#### GPS

1/2 or 1/4 day program Grade Appropriate: 6-12

This rare program will give participants the op- portunity to learn about and operate handheld global positioning systems in fun and interactive challenges. Students will not only learn about the handheld devices but also about GPS as a whole.

# **Team Building**

1/2 day or 1/4 day program Grade Appropriate: 3-12

Our team building program consists of a variety of games and challenges focused on promoting teamwork, communication and trust in a group. With an emphasis on debriefing, **Our 5 Senses** 

Indoor/Outdoor

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1/2 day program Grade Appropriate: JK-3

Participants will use their sense of touch, smell, sight, hearing, and taste as they make their way through this program. Students will take part in interactive games that will isolate specific senses, and allow them to further their understanding of the natural world. The activities are focused on how different animals rely on their senses for survival.

# **Animal Games**

1/2 or 1/4 day program Grade Appropriate: JK-3

Participants will learn about various animal behaviors and habitats by participating in interactive stimulation games that demonstrate various animal behaviors, habitats, abilities, and specific characteristics.

### Nature's Art Class

1/2 day program or 1/4 day program Grade Appropriate: JK-12

This program introduces the basics of art design and has the participants explore the outdoors to find these principles reflected in nature. The participants will be encouraged to look at various elements such as colour composition, textures, shapes, space, and lines that are found in a natural setting. They will then have the opportunity to incorporate these principles into their own creation using materials they have collected during their exploration of the outdoors
